

November, 2021n to welcome back our Winter Snow Birds (ok, some)! We certainly missed you and are glad to see you. I hope all is well with you and your family.

<u>COVID</u>: Cases are still being reported so please use caution when in the public areas and in particular using our facilities. Wipes and sprays are available in certain locations, so wipe down exercise machines and areas that you touch. Older adults and those with underlying conditions are more susceptible so please use caution and wear a mask if your immune system is compromised. We just want you to be safe!

<u>VETERANS</u>: Happy Veterans Day, (November 11th) to those who are VETS. We appreciate so very much your service to our country.

<u>US POSTAL SERVICE</u>: We were notified that beginning October 1^{st} , the USPS is modifying their service standards for First Class Mail. Under the new standards they will expand their delivery window from 1-3 days to 1-5 days. This will affect those residents who pay via coupon and the timing of those payments being applied. Please make sure to mail your payments earlier to accommodate their new standards. If payments are not paid by the 5^{th} of the month, you will incur a \$25.00 late fee. Another option for payments would be ACH or bill pay. Let me know if you are interested in either of those and I will be glad to assist you.

<u>COUPON BOOKS</u>: If you pay your lot rent by coupon, please note that new coupon books will be sent to you in December. If you would like to sign up for ACH so that your payment is made automatically on the 3^{rd} of the month, please contact me. Otherwise, keep in mind the new postal standards described above and make sure to mail your payment earlier so as not to incur a late fee. (Payments are due on the 1^{st} of the month and late after the 5^{th} of the month.)

<u>DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME</u>: ends 2:00 AM on Sunday, November 7th. Please remember to turn your clocks back one hour before you go to bed on Saturday. Enjoy the extra hour!

<u>PETS:</u> Please be mindful of the pet regulations which are stated in Section G:31 of the Rules and Regulations. This is also a respect issue. A portion which I have the most complaints on follows:

• Pets must be restrained on a hand-held leash. Pets may not be "tied out" without proper supervision. Pets are not permitted on other residents' lots or on Common Ground at any time. Pets may be walked on the Community streets ONLY and residents MUST pick up any droppings immediately and deposit them in their own trash receptacles upon returning home.

SAUSAGE & TORTELLINI SOUP

9.6 oz sausage crumbles (1 bag)

2 TBSP. minced garlic

29 oz chicken broth (2 - 14.5 cans)

9 oz. refrigerated cheese tortellini

1-1/2 cups water

14.5 petite diced tomatoes

1 cup fresh baby spinach chopped (can use frozen)

1 tsp, basil

1 tsp. garlic salt

Salt & Pepper to taste

Shredded parmesan cheese

INSTRUCTIONS:

Add sausage crumbles and garlic to a large pot and cook for 1 minute. Stir in broth, water and tomatoes and bring to boil.

Add tortellini and cook for 6-7 minutes

Reduce heat to low and add spinach, basil, salt and pepper. Cook for more minutes and serve warm with parmesan cheese on top. Bon Appetit
