BREAKFAST PIZZA

- 1 can of Crescent Rolls
- 1 pound of sausage, crumbled and cooked
- 1 8 oz. mozzarella cheese
- 4 eggs beaten
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup of milk
- Salt and Pepper to taste


In a greased 9 x 13 pan, unroll the crescent rolls. Spread cooked sausage on top of rolls. Sprinkle cheese over sausage. Beat eggs and milk with salt and pepper. Pour on top and cook for 20-25 minutes at 425 until lightly browned and set. Bon appetite!


