TAG RENEWAL: As most of you are aware, the tags for your home expired December 31, 2020. They are to be renewed every year and it is your responsibility to take care of. Attached is a letter from the tag office which I received January 6th. This provides information pertaining to your tags and should answer any questions you might have.

COVID-19: The Department of Health in County Manatee is offering COVID-19 Florida vaccinations to full-or part-time residents aged 65 and older by appointment only, as supply is available. Manatee County is implementing a vaccine standby pool that will seniors pre-register to at vax.mymanatee.org or by calling 311 to receive their first dose as vaccines become available. Please continue to follow the CDC guidelines for social distancing. We do request that you wear a mask when entering the Club House and Rec Hall. Also, please continue to wipe down the areas that you use at the pool, in the Rec Hall, (especially the equipment), and the Club House table and chairs in order to help prevent the spread of this disease.

PAINTING: Weather permitting, the sidewalk by the Rec Hall and the mailboxes will be painted on Monday, February 15th. (Keep in mind the mail does not deliver that day.) Another coat will also be applied to the Club house sidewalk. (The back laundry sidewalk will be available.) So, both the Rec Hall and Club House will be closed Monday and Tuesday. please don't drive your golf cart by the mailboxes to allow for it to cure. You will still have access to the pool using the south gate only. Please be respectful and do not walk on the areas that will be sectioned off.

GOLF CARTS: It would be appreciated, (and if you are able), if you would park your golf cart in the parking lot instead of driving across the common area and parking up close to the pool. If you have a disability, it is understandable. Also, please don't park on the cement. You may if you are disabled, currently park on the grassy area up by the south west area of the pool.

HOME APPEARANCE: THANK YOU! THANK YOU! to those who are power washing your homes, painting your drive ways, and weeding. I know this is the time of year when it is really noticed and the power washing should be done annually. We still have quite a few homes in the park that are in need of attention. Don't forget the awnings!
