RETURN PAYMENTS: A new policy will go into effect on March 3rd, 2025 regarding returned payments. Once I receive a notice that your payment has been returned, I can only accept verified funds as payment (i.e., Cashier's Check or Money Order). We will no longer accept a personal check, process an ACH or process a payment through the Resident Portal for a minimum of 90 days. It will have to be via verified funds as stated above. For those that were on ACH and want to continue that form of payment, you will need to reapply after the 3-month probation period. For any questions, please don't hesitate to contact me.

TRASH: Please make sure that your trash and yard waster is either in a can, bag or tied up. The county will not pick it up unless you adhere to their regulations.

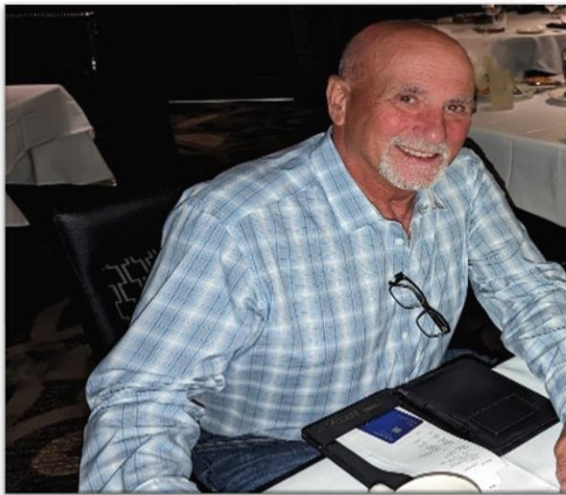
