<u>PET REMINDER</u>: Please keep your pet on a leash at all times. They are not allowed to roam and we have had a couple pets running loose. This is documented in Section G:31. Please review but here is a portion of it:

A All pets must be registered with the Community Office. All dogs and cats must be licensed & vaccinated.

Copies of those documents must be filed with the Community Office

B <u>Pets must be restrained on a hand-held</u> <u>leash</u>. <u>Pets may not be "tied out"</u>

<u>without proper supervision</u>. Pets are not permitted on other residents' lots or on Common Ground at any time. Pets may be walked on the Community streets ONLY and <u>residents MUST pick up any droppings</u> <u>immediately and deposit them in their own</u> <u>trash receptacles upon returning home.</u>

<u>HOME APPEARANCE</u>: A hearty thank you to the residents who have been cleaning their homes. It is great to get a jump start on the spring cleaning while also being in compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the Park. There are still homes that need painting or attention to certain areas like steps, awnings, back yards, etc. Please contact the office to let me know of your intentions.
